Regulation No. 30/22 of the Rector of Poznan University of Medical Sciences of 22nd February 2022

on the organization of education and classes in spring semester of academic year 2021/2022 from 7th March 2022

With regard to the regulation of the Council of Ministers of 6th May 2021 on introducing certain restrictions, orders and bans with regard to the emergence of the state of epidemic (Journal of Laws 2021.861 as amended), pursuant to § 28 paragraph 1 of the Statute of Poznan University of Medical Sciences, it is resolved as follows:

§ 1

Following the schedule of academic year 2021/2022 in spring semester, the following organization of the teaching and classes will apply at Poznan University of Medical Sciences from 7th March 2022:

- 1) lectures will be held with the use of remote teaching methods and techniques;
- 2) seminars will be held in stationary (on-site) form;
- 3) in duly justified cases with the appropriate Faculty's Dean/Director of Center for Medical Education in English approval, expressed upon course coordinator's request, it is possible to change the form of organizing classes mentioned in point 1) and 2);
- classes carried out by Foreign Languages Study Centre will be held in hybrid form including stationary (on-site) classes and the use of remote teaching methods and techniques. The decision on the form of the classes will be taken by the Head of Foreign Languages Study Centre;
- 5) classes in Doctoral School and postgraduate education will be held in stationary (on-site) form or with the use of remote teaching methods and techniques. The decision on the form of the classes will be taken by Vice-Rector for Doctoral School and Post-Graduate Education (with reference to Doctoral School) and by Vice-Rector for Doctoral School and Post-Graduate Education or Chief Executive Office (with reference to postgraduate education) at course coordinator's request.

§ 2

The execution of the regulation is hereby entrusted to the Vice-Rector for Educational Affairs.

§ 3

This Regulation becomes effective as of the date of its signing.
