Regulation No. 8/21

of the Rector of Poznan University of Medical Sciences of 5th February 2021

on the organisation of education and academic year 2020/2021

According to § 28 para. 1 of the Statutes of Poznan University of Medical Sciences, it is resolved as follows:

§ 1

To the extent not regulated hereunder, within the scope of the regulations of the Rector of Poznan University of Medical Sciences: No. 52 of 28th May 2020 (amended by the regulations No. 82 of 17th July 2020 and No. 88 of 6th August 2020) And No. 82 of 17th July 2020 (amended by the regulation No. 90 of 18th August 2020):

- 1. In the period from 22nd February 2021, until further notice, taking into account the time schedule for 2020/2021 academic year, all teaching classes will only be conducted using remote teaching methods and techniques, with the exclusion of classes referred to in paragraphs 2 and 3.
- 2. From 1st March 2021, all classes developing practical skills shall take place in an in-person (stationary) form. It is recommended that practical clinical classes be carried out in an in-person form as from 8th March 2021. Under exceptional circumstances, with the Dean's approval, the organisation of such classes using remote teaching methods and techniques will be allowed.
- 3. As from 1st March 2021, under exceptional circumstances, with the Dean's approval, seminars can be organised in an in-person form, provided that these are classes developing practical skills.
- 4. Direct examinations at the Centre for Innovative Education Techniques (Centrum Innowacyjnych Technik Kształcenia CITK) are postponed until further notice.
- 5. Post-graduate education and classes in Doctoral School shall only be carried out using remote teaching methods and techniques, except for the classes developing practical skills.
- Guidelines for the students and university teachers associated with the organisation of education in the academic year 2020/2021, including all policies concerning the observance of the rules limiting the risk of SARS-CoV-2 virus transmission shall remain valid.
- 7. According to the regulation of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of 26th July 2019 on the standards of education preparing for the practice of the profession of a medical doctor, dentist, pharmacist, nurse, midwife, laboratory diagnostician, physiotherapist, and paramedic (Journal of Laws of 2019.1573 as amended), students of the studies preparing for the practice of the profession of a medical doctor, dentist, pharmacist,

nurse, midwife, laboratory diagnostician, physiotherapist, and paramedic, working in the Temporary Hospital at MTP or performing activities within the tasks executed by other treatment facilities or sanitary and epidemiological services concerning SARS-CoV-2 infections, are entitled to apply for having their courses passed under the terms and conditions specified by the Dean of the Faculty.

§ 2

- 1. The execution of the regulation is hereby entrusted to the Vice-Rector for Education in cooperation with the Deans of Faculties, the Director of CMEE and the Director of the Doctoral School.
- 2. Deans of the Faculties, the Director of CMEE and the Director of the Doctoral School are hereby obligated to adjust their prior decisions concerning the arrangement of teaching classes to this regulation.

§ 3

This Regulation becomes effective as of the date of signing.
